First aid supplies

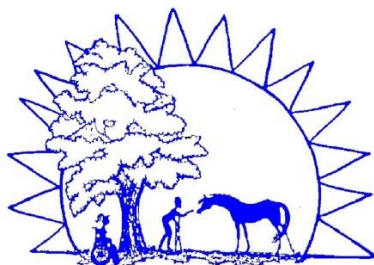
Rider helmets
